




A one-day workshop on road safety was attended at the DC Office on 28 July 2025 under the chairmanship of the Deputy Commissioner, **Sh. Anupam Kashyap ji**, as per the directions received from higher authorities. The workshop was organized with the objective of sensitizing stakeholders about road safety measures, with special emphasis on challenges and precautions required in hilly areas. The Superintendent of Police, Shimla, **Sh. Sanjeev Gandhi**, along with other senior officials from the Department of Police, elaborated in detail various road safety rules and regulations applicable to mountainous terrains. Key issues such as safe driving practices on narrow and winding roads, adherence to speed limits, use of safety gear, vehicle fitness, proper signage, and awareness among drivers and pedestrians were discussed thoroughly. The officials highlighted the increasing incidence of road accidents in hilly regions and stressed the need for strict compliance with traffic norms to minimize loss of life and property. From GDC Chail Koti, the **Road Safety Nodal Officer, Prof. Devender Singh**, attended the workshop and actively participated in the deliberations. During the workshop, it was collectively urged by all the attendees that coordinated and collective efforts from administration, police, educational institutions, and the general public are essential to avoid road accidents. It was emphasized that all prerequisites, including awareness programs, enforcement of rules, regular monitoring, and adoption of preventive measures, must be ensured in the future. The workshop concluded with a strong resolve to work together towards promoting a culture of road safety and ensuring safer roads, particularly in hilly areas.
